

# ED Data Express Data Download Tool User Guide

## Overview

The data download tool allows users to create their own customizable datasets of the *EDFacts* data stewarded by the Office of Elementary and Secondary Education (OESE) based on the filters listed below. Currently data are available on school years 2010-11 through 2017-18.

### **(1) Federal Formula Grant Program (referred to as ‘Program’)**

### **(2) State**

In general, data are available on the 50 States, District of Columbia, Bureau of Indian Education, and Puerto Rico.

### **(3) Reporting Level (referred to as ‘Level’)**

Most data are available at the State Education Agency (SEA) and Local Educational Agency (LEA) level. School district is often used interchangeably with LEA. Please note that school districts are often a subset of the LEAs in a State. Additional categories of LEAs may include service agencies, supervisory unions, and independent charter districts. ### **(4) School Year**

Data are currently available on school years 2010-2011 to 2017-18. The data represented on the site are collected annually. In general, the site will be updated during the summer and fall with another school year of data.

### **(5) Data Topic**

Data are available on participation and performance outcomes.

### **(6) Sub-Population**

A significant amount of the data available for download are available disaggregated by sub-populations or subgroups. Please note that not all datasets are disaggregated by the same sub-populations. For more information on available disaggregations, hover over the values in the ‘File Spec’ or ‘Data Group’ filter.

### **(7) Age/Grade**

Like sub-population, a significant amount of the data available for download are available disaggregated by age and/or grade-level. The available age/grade-level permitted values vary by dataset.

### **(8) Other Filters**

a. *EDFacts* File Specification (referred to below as ‘File Spec’)

The data available for download through the data download tool are collected by the Department through the *EDFacts* Initiative. In *EDFacts*, collections of data are referred to as and organized into file specifications. For more information, visit <https://www2.ed.gov/about/inits/ed/edfacts/index.html>. As noted above under the Sub-Population filter description, additional information on a file specification is available by hovering over the file specification value.


b. *EDFacts* Data Group (referred to below as ‘Data Group’)

Data group is another *EDFacts* term used to refer to a more specific data collection with a standardized definition. File specifications can contain more than one data group. Like file specification, additional information is available by hovering over the data group value.


## How to Use the Data Download Tool

### Navigating to the Data Download Tool

Because of the volume of data available, the site defaults to a subset of data depending on the link you use to get to the data download tool. When you click on the “Download” button from the landing page (see screenshot below), the data download table defaults to the most recently available district-level adjusted-cohort graduation rate data (FS150/DG695). The Data Download Tool provides a preview of your dataset; for a comprehensive view, please download the data following the steps in the section titled, “Downloading Datasets.”



If you navigate to the download tool from a dashboard, the data download tool will default to the data for the program you were just viewing. For example, if you click on “Data Download Tool” from the McKinney-Vento Act dashboard, you will see just the data for this program.

### Creating Customized Datasets

To create your own customized dataset, click “Reset Filters”. This will update the tool so that the filters show all available permitted values for the most recent school year. You may also switch school years or show data for multiple school years using the “School Year” filter.

Please note that the tool updates every time a filter is selected. You will be unable to select any additional filters until the update is complete. During this time, the cursor will appear as the following symbol:

### Downloading Datasets

Once you have selected all the filters you want, you can download the data as a .csv data file as well as any data notes applicable to the data you selected by clicking “Download Data” located to the bottom right of the data preview table. The data notes provide information on data anomalies present in the data or other contextual information the Office of Elementary and Secondary Education learned through its data verification process.
